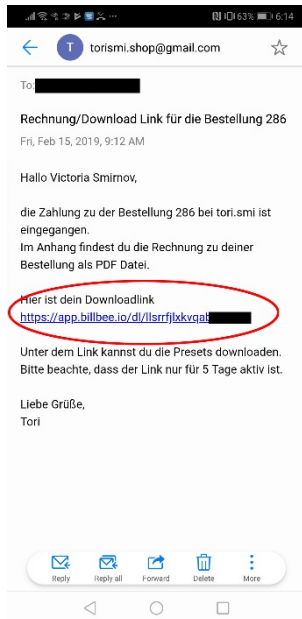

How do I install the presets?

Lightroom CC app - **android**

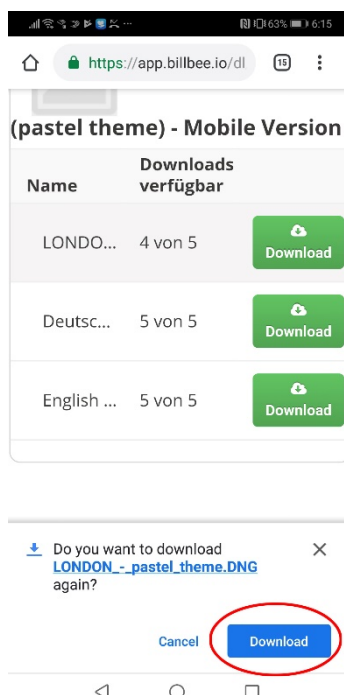
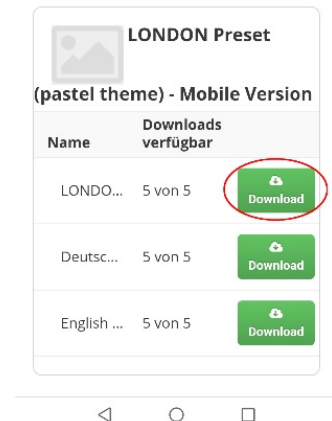
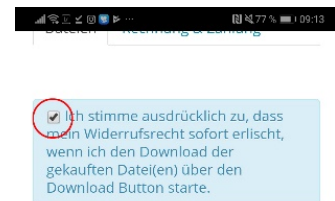
* Since the Lightroom CC app for android unfortunately has a bug when using the "Create Preset" function instead we will use the "Copy Setting" function.



1. After you have purchased one or more presets, you will automatically receive a **mail** containing your personal link to the download portal.

2. Click on the **link** to get to the download portal.

3. Before you can download the presets, you must **tick** the box that informs you about your right of withdrawal. Now you can click on "**download**".

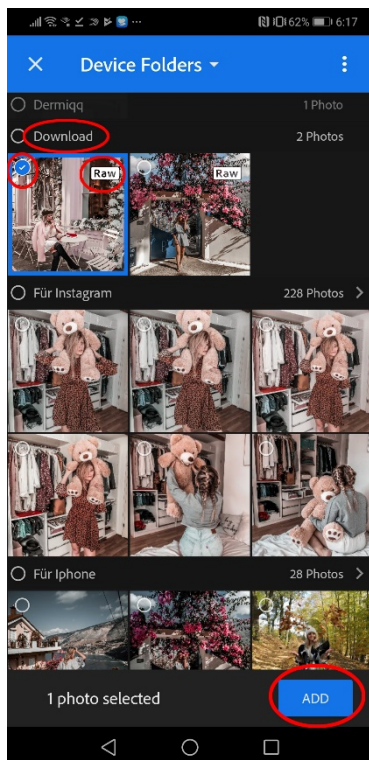
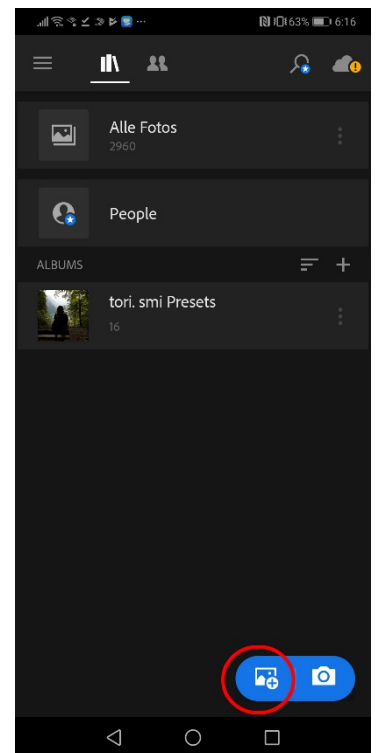


4. An info box may now appear at the bottom of your screen asking if you want to download the file. Just click on "**download**".

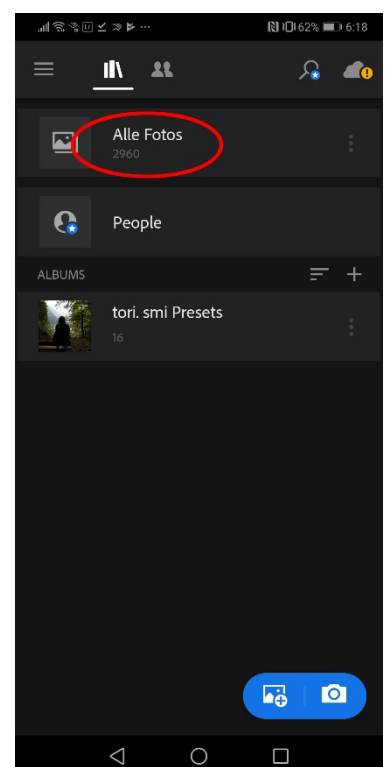
(The preset now automatically saves itself in your gallery, usually under downloads).

5. Now **open** the lightroom cc app on your mobile phone

6. and **click** on the "add images" icon at the bottom right.

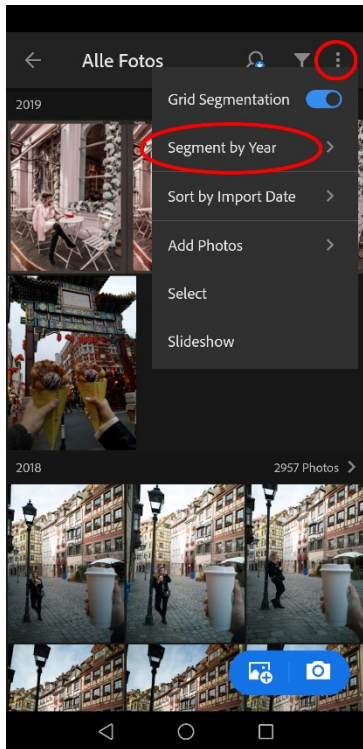


7. An overview of your stored photos opens on the screen. First click on the image that contains the preset to highlight it and then click "**ADD**" at the bottom right. The image is usually saved under "download" and marked with "**Raw**" in the upper right corner.



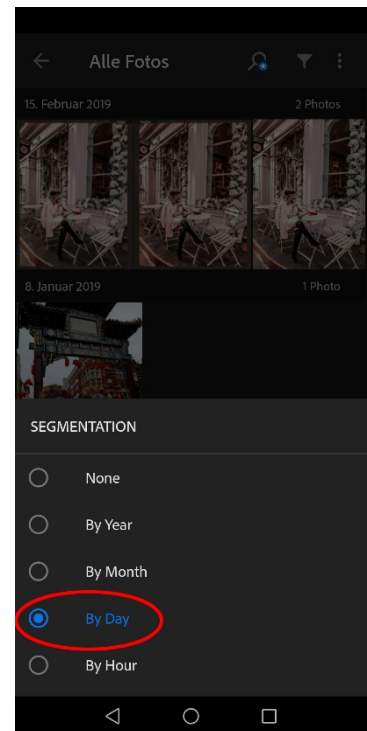
8. Now go to "**All photos**" in the app starting overview.

If you don't find the picture immediately, follow the instruction's steps 9-10. If you have already found it, click on the picture and continue with step 11.



9. So, if you don't find the picture immediately, go to the **3 dots** in the upper right corner. Select the **segmentation option** here.

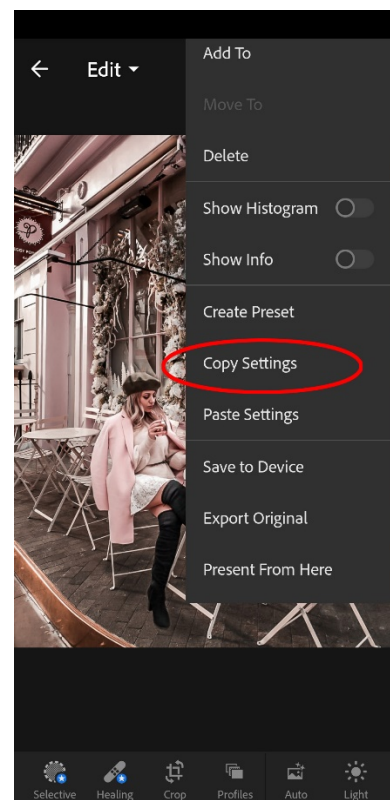
10. A small menu opens on the screen, as you can see on the right picture. Select "**Segmentation by day**". The image should now be displayed at the top under "All photos". Click on the picture and



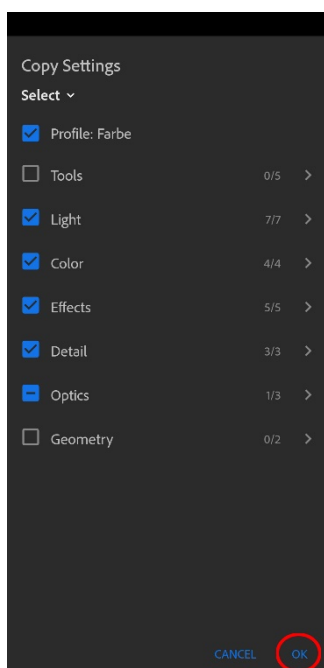
11. then go to the **3 dots** at the top right corner again.

12. *Click now on "**Copy Settings**".

***Note:** As mentioned at the beginning of the introduction, there is a bug in the android lightroom app that prevents us from using the "Create Preset" feature. This function always causes a faulty display of the preset. Therefore, we use the "Copy Settings" function. Unfortunately, this process must be repeated every single time you want to use a preset.

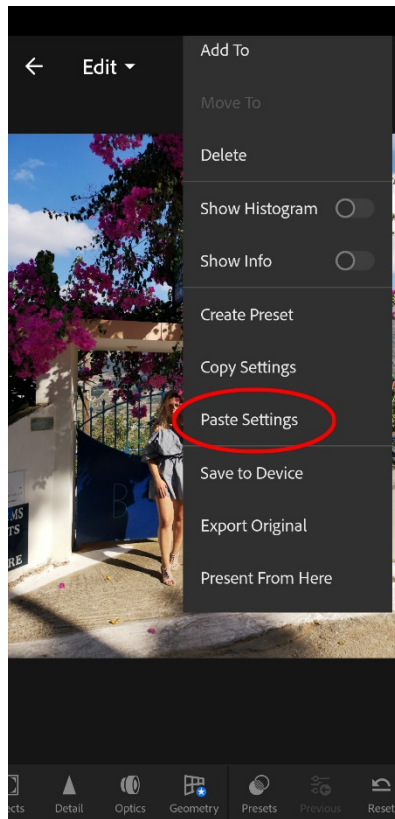


13. An overview appears. It shows us which tools we want to copy into the new image. We leave these at the default settings as they can be seen in the picture on the left and click on "**OK**" on the bottom right.



14. Now we go to the picture which we want to edit with the preset. We press the **3 dots** in the upper right corner to open our options menu.





15. Now we select the option "**Paste Settings**" and voilà, the selected image has the preset on.

2. Click on the **link** to get to the download portal.

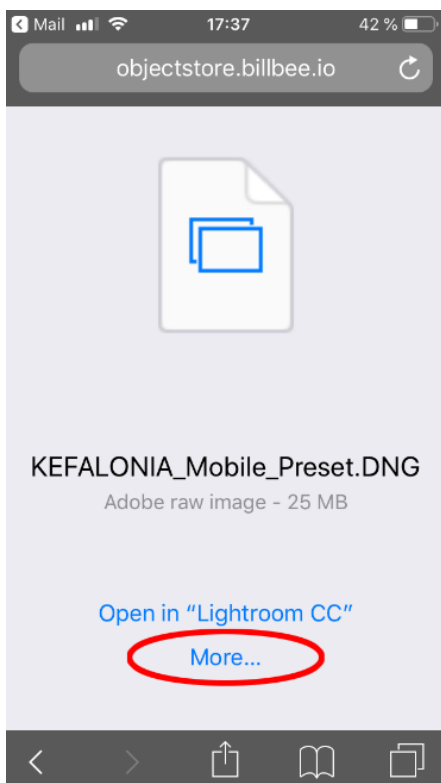

3. Before you can download the presets, you must **tick** the box that informs you about your right of withdrawal.
4. Now you can click on **download**. Do not click all download links at once (!). Click on a download button and wait briefly (!).

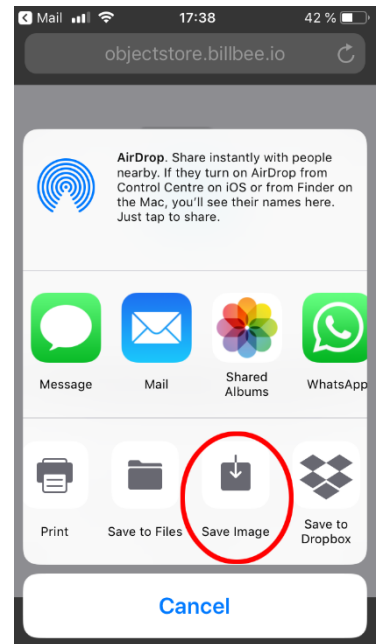

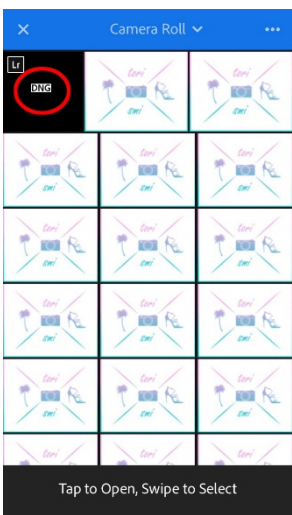
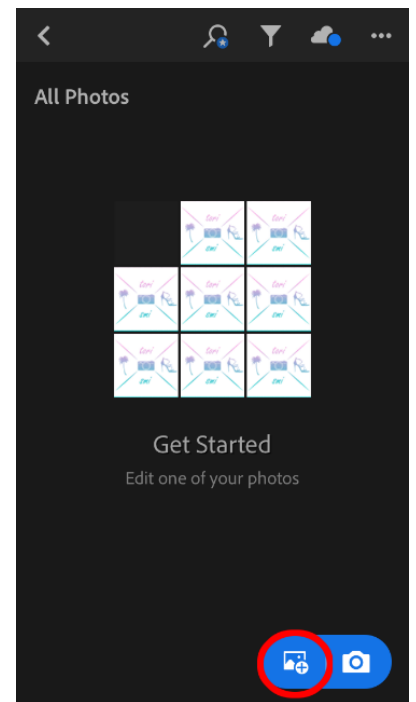
5. A window should open automatically as shown on the left image. Now simply click on **"More..."**.

6. A menu should pop up where you click on "**Save Image**". If you don't see this option, just scroll in the menu to the right.



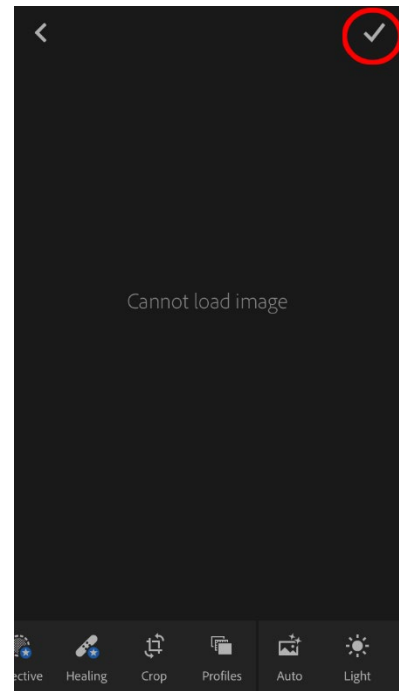
7. The image may appear black, gray or white in your gallery. You don't have to worry about it. It's normal. Now **open** the lightroom cc app on your mobile phone

8. and **click** on the icon for "add images" at the bottom right.



9. An overview with all your pictures will open. Click on the image that contains the preset. It appears, as mentioned above, mostly black and labelled with **DNG**.

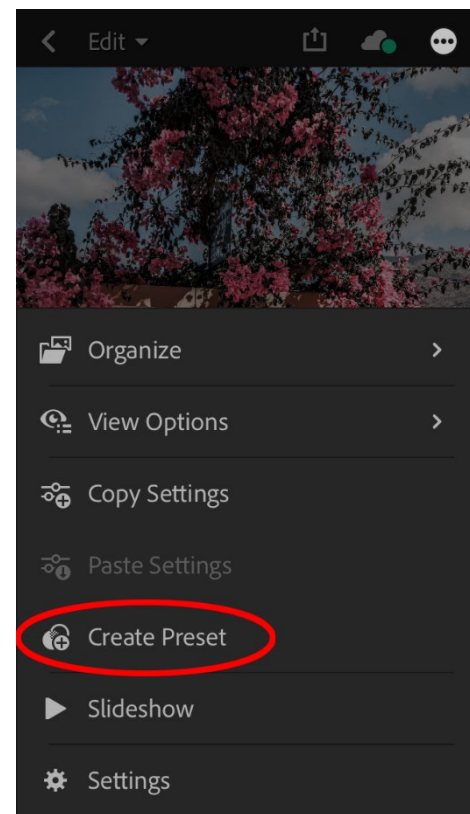
10. Now all you must do is click on the "**check**" in the upper right corner. You can safely ignore the message that the image cannot be loaded.

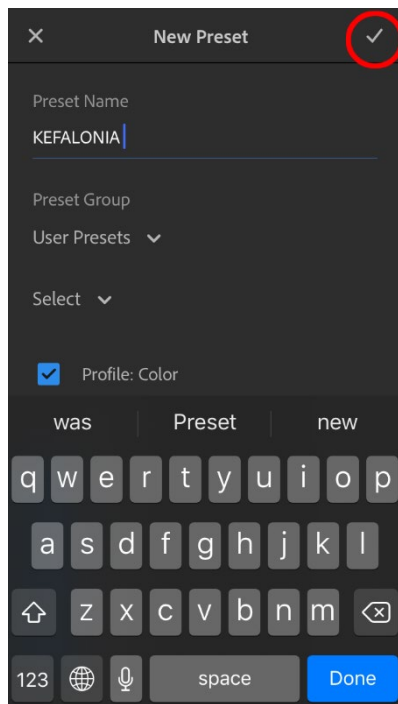


11. After the import is finished, go to the image and click on the "**3 dots**" in the upper right corner.



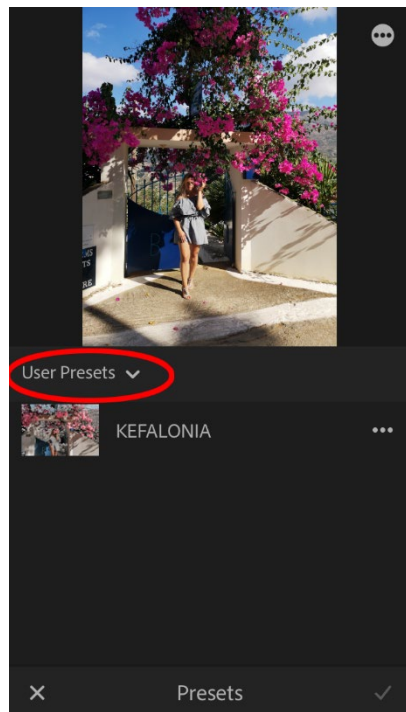
12. Click on "**Create Preset**" and enter a name for the preset. The best way not to get confused is to take the preset's name. Do not change the settings.





13. Now click on the "**check**" again on the upper right. The preset is now saved under "Presets".

14. Open any image (for this example I chose the original image) and press "**Presets**" at the bottom of the menu bar. If you don't see this option, just scroll to the right.



15. A menu should pop up. Go to "**User Presets**" in the drop-down menu at the top. There you can find your saved preset. You can now edit any image with this preset.
